Permanent Secretaries, Heads of Department and Chief Executive Officers are asked to invite applications from suitably qualified officers in their Ministries/Departments/Agencies to be assigned to the Laboratory Technician (SOG/ST 2) – (Not Vacant) in Research and Development Division, Ministry of Agriculture, Fisheries and Mining, salary range \$1,550,136 - \$2,084,761 per annum.

Job Purpose

Under the supervision of the Plant Protection Officer (SOG/ST 5), the Laboratory Technician (SOG/ST 2), is responsible in ensuring that full laboratory support is provided for research, pest identification, diagnostic and regulatory work.

Key Responsibilities

Technical/Professional

- Prepares laboratory reagents and culture media for diagnostic work;
- Collects, registers, and prepares specimens and samples brought to the laboratory for identification of pests and diagnosis by the Plant Protection Officers;
- Maintains Laboratory records;
- Performs chemical analyses on animal samples brought in by farmers;
- Operates Laboratory equipment which assists in the analysis of samples;
- Ensures that reference collection is adequately maintained;
- Assists with orientation/training of students from Secondary/Tertiary Institutions.

Other

- Visits farms and other holdings to assists Plant Protection Officers with field work;
- Performs any other related duties which may be assigned from time to time.
