Permanent Secretaries, Heads of Department and Chief Executive Officers are asked to invite applications from suitably qualified officers in their Ministries/Departments/Agencies to be assigned to the post of Assistant Food Storage Scientist (SOG/ST 4) – (Not Vacant) in the Food Storage and Prevention of Infection Division, Ministry of Industry, Investment and Commerce, salary range \$2,478,125 - \$3,332,803 per annum.

Job Purpose

Under the direction of the Food Storage Scientist, the Assistant Food Storage Scientist ensures that food/feed in commerce are not contaminated by rodent: hair, faeces and urine; which can cause food/feed losses, disease spread and condemnation by local and international authorities.

Key Responsibilities

Administrative:

- Maintains Unit records;
- Assists in the preparation of laboratory manual;
- Assists in the procurement of laboratory equipment and supplies;
- Performs any other administrative duties of the Unit as directed.

Technical/Professional:

- Assists in sample analyses;
- Maintains a laboratory population of rodents;
- Assists in the selection and rearing of wild and laboratory strain rodents;
- Assists in the procurement of wild and laboratory strain rodents;
- Assists in conducting bioassays and fields experiments;
- Assists the FSS in conducting routine inspections;
- Assists the FSS in conducting disinfestation activities in the control rodents;
- Carries out the basic duties of all Assistant Food Storage Scientist in other laboratories;
- Represents the Unit at events as deem necessary ...

Required Knowledge, Skills and Competencies

- Ability to work with small animals;
- Good oral and written communication skills;
- Basic computer skills;
- Excellent technical knowledge on the job;
- HACCP competence.

Minimum Required Qualification and Experience

- Laboratory Technician Certification from a recognized tertiary institution; OR
- Associate Degree in Natural Sciences from a recognized tertiary intuition; OR
- Diploma in Food technology;
- Two (2) years' working experience in a recognized laboratory;
- Training in food safety systems eg. HACCP.

Special Conditions Associated with the Job

- Sometimes dusty warehouse conditions;
- Musty working conditions;
- Hazards: climbing and crawling;
- Flexibility to travel and work on weekends/public holidays;
- Flexibility in working hours i.e. begin work early, end work late or extended hours in service;
- Working with chemicals.
